DF09 Restricted Practice Derogation

Reason for use:

Application for approval to carry out a restricted practice.

Conditions

- Derogation approval must be gained annually from QWFC for the docking of lambs tails or the castration of male animals;
- Derogation to bring in beak tipped poultry must be obtained prior to the birds arrival on site, the derogation request will be forwarded to DEFRA for their decision;
- Derogation to beak tip an existing flock must be gained prior to carrying out the operation, the derogation request will be forward to DEFRA for their decision;
- For beak tipping, the relevant section of the Poultry Health Plan must be enclosed with the derogation request along with a letter from the farm vet advising on the beak tipping of the poultry;

QWFC may request additional information before a decision can be made.
